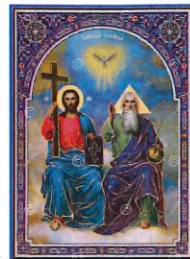

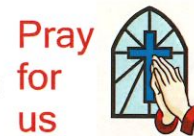

Prayer for Memorial Day

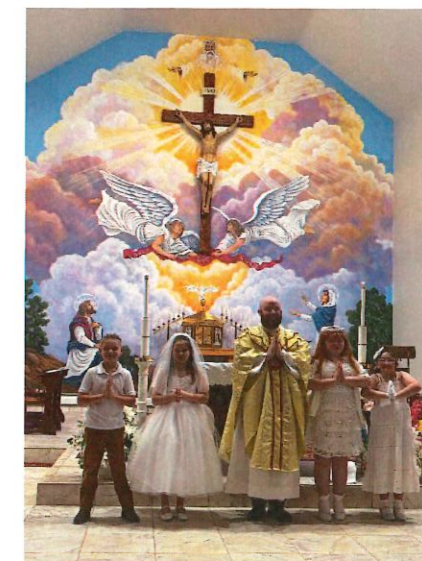
