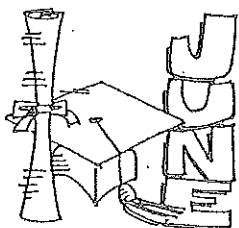

Hunger Never Takes a Summer Vacation: In the United States, approximately 22 million children rely on free or reduced-priced meals during the school year, yet only 2.7 million access free meals in the summer when school is out. In the six counties that make up the Diocese of Youngstown – Ashtabula, Columbiana, Mahoning, Portage, Stark and Trumbull Counties – 52% of our students are on a free or reduced-priced meal program during the school year. One out of five children in our six county service area is experiencing hunger or are at risk for hunger right now. Catholic Charities' Summer Hunger Campaign will run from June 1 – August 31 to help fight the summer hunger problem in our diocese. People are needed to pray, volunteer, and donate. A contribution of \$20.00 to the Summer Hunger Campaign will provide 4 children with a light breakfast and a lunch for an entire week.
